

INSURANCE – WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

Who can I teach? What licence do I need? What's my insurance cover?

Here are the answers to those 'grey area' questions and queries about AUSTSWIM's suite of accreditation, licensing and insurance.

My AUSTSWIM Licence is current – who can I teach?

The table details who you are accredited and insured to teach for the licence you hold. Please note the AUSTSWIM licence and

insurance can only be deemed current with:

- 1. Current CPR competency certification
- 2. Current Working With Children Check (WWCC) for the workplace state/territory
- 3. Compliance with AUSTSWIM teaching guidelines and Code of Conduct

Teacher of Adults	16+ years	It is preferred that teachers taking adult classes hold this licence extension however it is

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		not at this point, mandatory for insurance purposes.
